Dear Co-Laborers,

Once again it is great to send greetings from hot Jamaica. We hope you are enjoying God's richest blessings.

We are so excited about what God is doing at Heritage Baptist Church. We had revival services the last week of April with different local pastors preaching each night, Sunday through Friday. The meetings were well attended and people were in the altar every night. We are thankful for God's moving and blessing in these services.

We are just about through with the new convert class. The 22<sup>nd</sup> of May we will be baptizing 6 new members, one lady and 5 men. These men include Mr. Ellington and Mr. Bennett who we had requested prayer for. Then we have one man joining by statement of faith. Pray for Sister Dawn, she was a J.W. for 7 years. She is paying a price for leaving them. Also pray for her husband who is lost and suffering with severe kidney problems. Pray for Bro. Winkle's wife. She is Catholic but she will come with him to Heritage for special services and is hearing the Word preached. Others who are lost and need prayer are: Mr. Brown, Raymond, Omar, Jason, Mr. Moore, Mr. McNab, and Mr. Cross.

Also the May 22<sup>nd</sup> is youth Sunday. We do this once a year and the youth group takes charge of the services; teaching, sing, and ushering. We invite a guest speaker for the morning Preaching Service.

My health is much better. I've not had any heart problems since I have been back. My arm is healing well. If it gets sore I have to pack it with ice. This means progress on the church building. We have already laid about 600 blocks. The 23<sup>rd</sup> of May is Labour Day here, we have about 40 people from the church coming to work on the building. Some of our members are also hiring masons. We hope to lay about 600 blocks then. The only problem we foresee is rain. We are in the middle of rainy season.

We will be ready for work groups to come after June 7<sup>th</sup>. We will be attending Albert's graduation from Tabernacle Baptist College in Greenville, SC on May 27<sup>th</sup>. Also I am to have another scan done on my kidney. Pray for Albert as He seeks God's will for his life. We are pleased to announce that Robert and Holly have another son, Thadd born May 4<sup>th</sup>. They already have a daughter, Sydney and a son, Layne. This gives us 4 grandsons and 3 granddaughters.
