Dear Brethren,

He walked in to the services the next day and said *"Preacher, I couldn't take any longer. I got out of bed and got on my knees and ask the Lord to save me"*. Hallelujah!!! The young mans name is Tommy. He had been coming to the services for the last several months. He's about 20 years of age. What a blessing to see God work in his life.

I was recently involved in an automobile accident. As I was turning in to the place that I live a women hit me from behind at 60 miles an hour. It flipped me end-over-end twice and I landed in the four-lane on the opposite side. **I was air lifted to Shock-Trauma in Baltimore.** I suffered a brain concussion and broken sternum (breast bone) in my chest. The first two weeks I could hardly get off the couch. I was out of the pulpit for three Sundays. I am feeling much better now. I'm still having problems with my head as far as dizziness, pounding in my ears, and headaches, as well as blurred vision at times. Please keep us in your prayers.

We recently had our **2nd annual Missions Conference.** Once again the Lord blessed us with an increase in our missions. We were able to take on three more mission works. I stand amazed at what the Lord is doing through our little group.

The week before I got in the wreck we knocked out another wall in the church. **Now we have a fellowship hall.** Before we had to pick up the chairs in the auditorium and put out the tables. Now all we have to do is dismiss and go into the adjacent room which is already set up with tables and chairs. We designed it so that we could also use it for more room in our services.

My wife and I recently spent about two hours in the home of some precious Jewish people. They have become good friends with us. His wife said I was the first one that he had not thrown out for witnessing to him. Indeed the week before I had the opportunity to witness to him for over an hour while his wife had gone to the store. He listened real well. They are a wonderful couple. Help us pray that the Lord would save them. Thank you all for your prayers and support.
